



Sewing Machine Cover



The sewing machine cover is an approximate measurement and yards for most machines. You should take a tape measure and start on the table in front of your machine and measure to the back of your machine. Also measure the width of the sewing machine. I found 18" X 31" to be a good measurement for the width and length of my sewing machine cover.

I purchased 18" X 45" of pre quilted single faced fabric for

the base and 18" X 45" for the lining. You will also need 2 different ribbons and rick rack. I purchased 5 1/4 yards of each ribbon and 2 packages of medium rick rack. I also purchased thread to match each ribbon and rickrack.

Cut 2 pockets from the base fabric and lining – 7" X 18". Right sides together sew the base to the lining at one long edge. Turn to right side and press the sewn edge. Add trims

Cut body and lining of sewing machine cover -28" X 18". Sew the pockets to the ends of the sewing machine cover: Place the right side of each pocket to the wrong side of the base and sew the long edge. Turn the pocket to the right side and baste the sides to the machine cover base. Apply the lining to the base, right sides together. Leave a hole for turning.

Apply the ribbon and rick rack trim to the ends. Cut width strips of trim and apply to the sewing machine cover.
