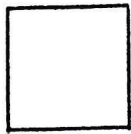


CATHEDRAL QUILT

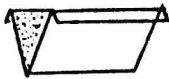
MACHINE STITCHED



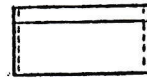
10" x 10"
muslin



fold in half

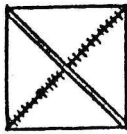


turn back $\frac{1}{2}$ "
at top

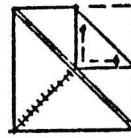


stitch $\frac{1}{2}$ " seams
on both sides

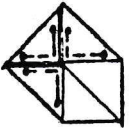
Trim corners and finger press seam open and turn to right side



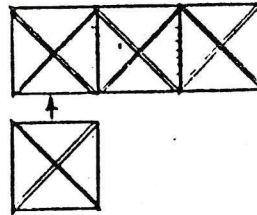
arrange squares with
seams in center and
bias edges on all
sides.



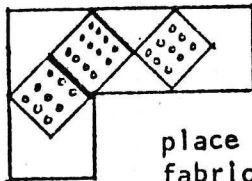
fold by bringing all
corners to center and
pin securely. or tack
with zig-zag machine
stitch.



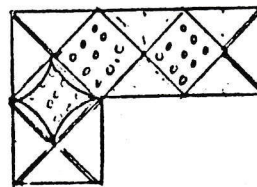
cut squares of
printed fabric to
fit over the muslin
squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "



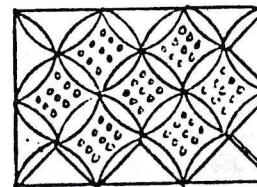
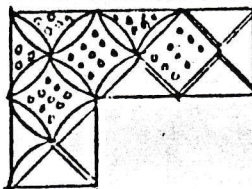
fagot the muslin squares
together using the feather,
zig-zag or mending stitch.



place the print
fabric over the
muslin squares



fold over the folded edge of
the muslin to cover the raw edge
of the print square. Feather
stitch in place.



This quilt needs no backing.
The wrong side resembles a
stitched flower bed and need
not be lined.
